



## HOUSEHOLD WASTE - WHAT GOES WHERE

### GREEN BIN:

**All items need to be clean & dry**

**RIGID PLASTICS** Plastic Drink Bottles, Plastic Cleaning Bottles, Butter + Yoghurt + Salad Tubs, Fruit + Veg. Trays, Plastic Milk Containers, Soap + Shampoo Bottles.

**TINS & CANS:** Soup Cans, Food Cans, Drink Cans, Pet Food Cans.

**PAPER & CARDBOARD** Letters, Brochures, Magazines, Phone Books, Catalogues, Cardboard Boxes (flat), Egg Boxes, Toilet + Kitchen Rolls, Cereal Boxes, Newspapers, Tetra Pack Juice + Milk Cartons.

### BROWN BIN

Kitchen scraps, Fruit + Veg., Bread, Pasta, Rice, Cake + Biscuits, Egg + Dairy Products, Cooked + Raw Foods, Tea Leaves/Bags, Coffee Grinds & Paper Filters, Meat, Fish, Poultry + Bones, out-of-date food products (with all packaging removed), Paper Napkins, Paper Towels, Pizza Boxes, Grass Clippings, Hedge Cuttings, very small Twigs, Leaves, Weeds, Moss, Plant Cuttings, Cut Flowers, Old Plants.

*Note: Any of the above can be wrapped in Biodegradable Bags*

### BLACK BIN

General Refuse, Plastic Bags, Polythene, Bubble Wrap, Nappies, Plastic Food Wrappings, Crisp Bags, Cling Film, Aluminium Foil, Ashes, Netting from Oranges + Onions, Broken Delph, Tooth Paste Tubes, Wax Paper Wrap, Old Candles, Contaminated Plastics, Plasters, Cotton Buds, Contents of Vacuum bag, Animal Waste.

#### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

**No Glass in ANY Bins above; instead bring to:**

- Bottle Bank at Dalkey Hill Car Park
- Bottle Bank at Dalkey Railway Station Car Park
- Eden Park Recycling Centre, Summerhill Road, Dun Laoghaire.

### Eden Park Recycling Centre, Dun Laoghaire accepts the following items

Aerosols, Aluminium Cans, Batteries e.g. AA, AAA, Cardboard, Glass, Light Bulbs & Fluorescent Tubes, Paper - Newspapers, Junk mail, Magazines, Books, Plastic Bottles, Plastic Packaging - Bags, Yoghurt Tubes, Bubble Wrap, Fruit + Veg Containers, Polystyrene (White), Printer Cartridges & Toners, Steel Cans, Food Tins, Biscuit Tins, Tetra Pak Containers: Milk, Juice, Soup Cartons, Textiles: Blankets, Shoes, Clothes, Curtains.

### Ballyogan Recycling Park, Dublin 18 accepts the following items

**Paper:** Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, phone books, white paper; **Cardboard;** **Polystyrene;** **Clean Plastic Packaging:** Plastic bags, Heavy duty wrapping, Yogurt cartons, Butter tubs, Cling film; **Plastic Bottles** - Soft drink, shampoo bottles, wash-up liquid, solid milk containers, other tough containers not easily torn, fruit + veg. packaging; **Aluminium drink cans;** **Steel Cans** - Including biscuit tins; **Glass Bottles** - Clear, brown and green bottles and jars (blue glass can be mixed with brown); **Tetra Pak** - Milk, juice and soup cartons; **Aerosols;** **Textiles** - Blankets, shoes, old clothes, curtains, bed linen; **Print Cartridges;** **Kitchen Appliances;** All **Light Bulbs;** **Batteries** (inc. car); **Gas Cylinders;** **Fire Extinguishers;** **Waste Oils** (cooking & motor); **Electronic and Electrical Waste;** **Metals;** **Sheet/Plate Glass.**

## CHARGEABLE ITEMS

### Ballyogan Recycling Park, Dublin 18 accepts the following items

Wood; Bulky items (e.g. furniture); General Waste; Soil, Stones and Household Construction and Demolition Waste; Green Garden Waste; Household Hazardous Waste.

**Note: No food waste, tyres or asbestos accepted.**
